Attention Clifton Residents:

For the past few days, City personnel have been assessing the damage caused by Hurricane Ida, And we have begun with the cleanup process. The City of Clifton Office of Emergency Management has been in communication with FEMA and the County OEM for updates on what assistance will be provided to residents, businesses and the City by FEMA. In preparing for the FEMA claims, kindly assess the damage in your property and prepare an inventory of all contents that were damaged or lost, this information is required when submitting a claim. The claim submission process will begin once FEMA makes this determination.

Please note that the amount of devastation caused by the storm is overwhelming, and it will take the City some time to remove these items. Kindly continue to put out any damaged items at the curb and the DPW will be in your area to collect it over the next few weeks. The DPW is also creating a list of damaged sidewalks and property damage, we have placed caution tape to protect residents from injury, before we proceed with the repairs we need to get clearance from FEMA.

DPW crews are still available to assist with the pumping out of flooded basements call the police non-emergency number 973-470-5911 for assistance. If you need assistance with food, bottled water, cleaning products, clothing, or other household goods we have non-profit organizations setting up distribution centers, for immediate assistance call Power of One, Kim Castellano at 201-328-2326.

I received a message from the Passaic Valley Water Commission to continue to boil drinking water in those areas most affected, if you need additional information kindly visit the PVWC website for instructions at www.PVWC.com .

If you are not signed up with the Swift 911 message system, please do so in order that we can reach out to you with updates and emergency messages.

PSE&G crews have been dispatched through the City to make repairs, and assist residents in shutting down or restoring power.

The City's Health Department has already relocated several residents that had to be evacuated from their homes, if you need assistance, please call me directly my cell is 201-303-8749.
