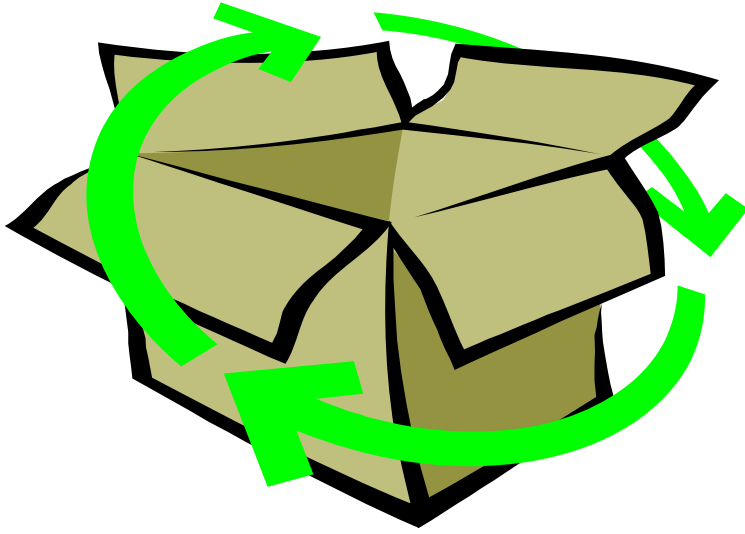


# Attention Clifton Residents, Businesses and Institutions!



## Cardboard Recycling Program Is Mandatory For Everyone

**Corrugated (Cardboard) boxes consist of all :**

**Cereal Boxes**

**Cookie Boxes**

**Shoe boxes**

**Packing and Shipping boxes**

**Tissue boxes**

**Egg cartons (cardboard only)**

**Boxes must be clean of any food waste or other debris.**

**No milk or juice cartons.**

Residents can recycle all Cardboard on their recycling collection day. Please check the Recycling Guide for your collection dates. Residents also have the option to bring cardboard to the recycling center at the City Hall complex located at 900 Clifton Avenue from 7:00 am till 7:00 p.m. Monday thru Saturday. Cardboard must be flattened and tied or placed neatly in other boxes.

Apartment and Condo owners that have a hauling company must recycle all cardboard and make arrangements with their hauling company to collect this material.

**Cardboard will NOT be collected with your garbage collection!**

# Businesses and Institutions! Cardboard Recycling

Businesses and Institutions must recycle all cardboard. If you utilize the City's curbside collection program you can place cardboard at the curb the night before your collection day. You also have the option to bring your cardboard to the recycling center at City Hall. If you have a hauler you still need to recycle all cardboard and must make arrangements with your hauler. The City provides a once a week collection of cardboard in various business sections. For further information regarding this collection please call the DPW at 973-470-2239.

Note: Residents, Commercial and Institutions that have their trash collected by a hauler still need to Recycle and must separate all cardboard boxes.
